

Application for mother tongue education at primary and secondary school

Children with a mother tongue other than Swedish are entitled to receive education in their mother tongue if:

- One or both of the child's parents or legal guardians have a language other than Swedish as their mother tongue,
- The other language forms the basis for the child's everyday communication at home, and
- The child has a basic level of proficiency in the other language.

The pupil's level of proficiency will be tested during a trial period of four weeks before permanent approval is granted.

The Municipality is obligated to arrange mother tongue education at primary and secondary school if there are at least five pupils who wish to receive education in the same language – *the exceptions to this rule are the official minority languages Finnish, Sami, Meänkieli, Romani chib and Yiddish* (the requirement of at least five pupils does not need to be met for these languages).

Adopted children are also entitled to receive mother tongue education if they have a basic level of proficiency in the language.

The mother tongue education is primarily arranged outside of the standard school curriculum and may not involve more than one language per pupil. If a pupil wishes to terminate his or her mother tongue education, a written application for termination must be submitted by the pupil's parents or legal guardians.
